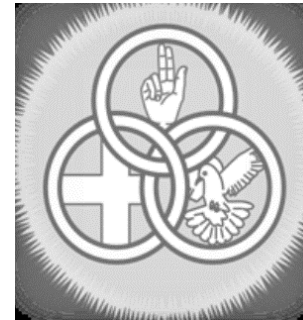

**Glory be to the Father and to
the Son and to the Holy Spirit**

We have now emerged from Eastertide – for last Sunday we celebrated the feast of Pentecost. Today's feast of the Most Holy Trinity seems to enclose the Paschal season and the whole liturgical year in our celebration of the central mystery of our faith.

Moses, in the **First Reading**, reminds the people of all that God has done for them. He is the one God, majestic and powerful, yet close to them.

The **Psalms** praise God for his love and faithfulness. God is the hope of all who revere him.

St Paul, in our **Second Reading**, reminds us that we have received the Spirit as sons and daughters of the Father, whom, like Christ, we can call Abba.

In the **Gospel** the disciples receive the commission to go forth and baptize all nations in the name of the Trinity, Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

This week, we pray to grasp something of the mystery of the blessed Trinity as we contemplate these scriptural texts.

Penwortham Farmers Market, which is held at St Teresa's Car Park, Queensway, Penwortham, PR1 0DS, will take place on Saturday 5th June. To comply with government guidelines, social distancing and best hygiene practices, most of the stalls will be outside, with just several inside the Scout Hut. We would ask everyone attending to wear a face mask when going inside. The market sells local produce which includes Eggs, Cheese, Meats Vegetables, Fruits, Fresh Fish, Jams, Plants, Cakes, Pies, Veggie Curries, Soaps, Wine, Gin, Fudge and hot coffees. Our craft stalls have also returned which helps make the market an interesting place to visit on a Saturday morning.

8th Penwortham St Teresa's Scouts Install Defibrillator: To celebrate their 2020, 50th anniversary celebrations, St Teresa's Scouts, set themselves the task of fund raising to purchase a defibrillator to be sited at St Teresa's Social Centre with the intention of highlighting Scouting's commitment to helping other people and supporting their local community.

After the parishioners of St Teresa's had donated £900 and the Scouts raised £400, Covid-19 put fund raising on hold until March this year, when the new Tesco Penwortham store boosted the Scouts' fundraising efforts by purchasing a defibrillator outright for them.

The good news is that the defibrillator was installed this week and it can be seen on the wall of the Social Centre as you leave Church. St Teresa's Scouts would like to thank everyone who has contributed to making this possible. Its wonderful that so many people recognise what a great organisation Scouting is and want to help and support its activities as it prepares our young people with Skills For Life.
